- (C) Maximum Age: Not above 35 years as on 01.01.2017 i.e. candidates must have been born not before 01.01.1982. Maximum age indicated is for General Category candidates. Relaxation in upper age will be available as below:

Vacancies are reserved for Disabled (Physically Challenged) Persons under Section 33 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996) as per government guidelines. Candidates with Orthopedic disabilities are eligible to apply as per the definitions given in the above act.

Only those OH candidates who have locomotor disability or cerebral palsy with locomotor impairment of minimum 40% and only those who fall in the following categories of the disabled are eligible to apply for the post
