(a) Cover-I (Technical Bid) : Technical bid envelope called “Electronic Format of Technical Bid” shall contain the following documents:

(i) Details of EMD and tender cost: Scan copy of Demand Draft must be uploaded in e-tender website along with technical bid

(ii) Electronic form of Technical Bid

Cover-I will be opened as per above mentioned date &time in the presence of Tenderers who desire to attend. The tenderers can view the Tender opening details through their respective log in Ids on the above-mentioned e-tender portal (Website).

(b) Cover-II (Price Bid) : Shall contain the Electronic format of Price Bid **ITEM RATE**.

· In case, the lowest Tendered Amount of two or more contractors is same, such lowest contractors will again be asked to submit sealed/online “Revised offers” on the original Estimated cost of the Tender including all sub sections/sub heads as the case may be. The lowest tender shall be decided on the basis of revised offers.

· The process of online re-bidding amongst two or more contractors offering same rates shall continue till L-1 bidder is discovered.

· In case, any of such contractor(s)(quoted same tender amount during initial bidding or subsequent re-bidding) refuses to submit revised offer, it shall be treated as “withdrawal of tender” by the contractor before acceptance. The earnest money of such contractors shall be forfeited.

· In case all the lowest contractors those have quoted same amount, refuse to participate in online revised bidding process for the project, the EMD of such contractors shall be forfeited and the tender shall be re-invited afresh for the project. The contractor(s), whose earnest money is forefeited because of non-submission of revised offer, shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process of the work.

· No condition/ stipulation in Cover-II other than unconditional general rebate shall be accepted. NOTE: Please note that above e-Tendering system is an automatically time locked system which

will be locked immediately as soon as due date and time is over and will not accept any offer after that. So, the tenderers are strictly advised to do their process well before the due date and time to avoid any such instances.

6. Tender Opening Event (TOE)

The e-Procurement portal offers a unique facility for 'Public/Limited Online Tender Opening Event (TOE)'. Tender Opening Officers as well as authorized representatives of bidders can attend the Public/Limited Online Tender Opening Event (TOE) from the comfort of their offices. For this purpose, representatives of bidders (i.e. Supplier organization) duly authorized are requested to carry a Laptop and Wireless Connectivity to Internet. Every legal requirement for a transparent and secure 'Public/Limited Online Tender Opening Event (TOE)' has been implemented on the portal.

As soon as a Bid is decrypted with the corresponding 'Pass-Phrase' as submitted online by the bidder himself (during the TOE itself), salient points of the Bids are simultaneously made available for downloading by all participating bidders. The tedium of taking notes during a manual 'Tender Opening Event' is therefore replaced with this superior and convenient form of 'Public/Limited Online Tender Opening Event (TOE)'. The portal has a unique facility of 'Online Comparison Chart' which is dynamically updated as each online bid is opened. The format of the chart is based on inputs provided by the Buyer for each Tender. The information in the Comparison Chart is based on the data submitted by the Bidders. A detailed Technical and/ or Financial Comparison Chart enhance Transparency. Detailed instructions are given on relevant screens. The portal has a unique facility of a detailed report titled 'Minutes of Online Tender Opening Event (TOE)' covering all important activities of 'Online Tender Opening Event (TOE)'. This is available to all participating bidders for 'Viewing/ Downloading'. There are many more facilities and features on the portal. IMPORTANT NOTE: In case of internet related problem at a bidder's end, especially during 'critical events' such as – a short period before bid-submission deadline, during online public/limited tender opening event, during e-auction, it is the bidder's responsibility to have backup internet connections. 7. Minimum Requirements at Bidders end

17. No conditions other than mentioned in the tender will be considered, and if given they will have to be withdrawn before opening of the price-bid.
18. The Bank reserve their rights to accept or reject any or all the tenders, either in whole or in part without assigning any reason(s) for doing so and no claim / correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
19. It will be the sole discretion of the Regional manager to whom tender documents/NIT will be issued.
20. Tenders received without EMD, Schedule & Tender Documents shall be summarily rejected.
21. In case the date of opening of tenders is declared as a holiday, the tenders will be opened on the next working day at the same time.
22. In case L-1 bidder quotes abnormally low rates (i.e. 10% or more, below estimated project cost), the bank may ask such bidder to deposit additional security deposit (ASD) equivalent to difference of estimated cost vis-à-vis L-1 quoted amount for due fulfillment of contract. Such ASD could be in the form of *Demand Draft Only*. On successful completion of work ASD will be returned to the contractor. 1. Tender duly filled signed in & sealed should be addressed to the Regional Manager, State Bank of India, RBO-3, 1st floor (behind SBI,ADB,Vidisha), Vivekanand Chauraha,Vidisha- 464001 so as to reach not later than 24.12.2021 upto 3:00 PM. The Tender will be opened at 3:30.PM on 24.12.2021 in the presence of such of the bidders or their authorized representatives, whosoever wish to remain present. The date and time of the opening of the Tender can be changed at the Bank's discretion. The envelope containing the enclosed price schedule, duly filled in along with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form of **Demand Draft only for Rs.4,500.00(Rupees four thousand five only)** in favour of The Regional Manager, State Bank of India, RBO-3, Vidisha should be super scribed with the "name of the work, last date of submission and date of opening" as advised herein, on the top. It is suggested that the tender be sent by registered post/personally so as to reach this office on or before the due date and time.

2. The other detailed terms and conditions of the tender are as under:

(i) No Tender will be accepted after 3:00 PM on the 24.12.2021 The Tender submitted will remain open for a period of ninety days from the Date of opening of tender.

(ii) Unsealed Tender will not be accepted. **All pages shall be signed and sealed.**

(iii) Tender with the corrections and/or overwriting will be liable to be rejected if they are not initialed for authentication. All rates should be in words and in figures.

(iv) Only the Tender which are complete in all respects with all information and contents/documents required will be taken into consideration. The contractor should quotes rates in all tender items are to be consider only, otherwise tender not consider.

(v) The contractor should quote their rates exclusive of GST (Goods & Service Tax). GST will be paid additional by the Bank as applicable subject to the condition of GST number. Other taxes, if any applicable are inclusive in the quoted rate. including wastage, transportation of material to the aforesaid work site, etc. If contractor quotes low rates then he will be required to deposit additional security deposit as decided by the Bank. If contractor quotes low rates then he will be required to deposit additional security deposit as decided by the Bank.

(a) Contractor has to engage reliable skilled workers and shall follow all labour laws and acts. The contractor to take all Risk Policy and Workmen compensation Policy pertaining to this job at his own cost.

(b) On completion of work rubbish etc. shall be removed as directed and site shall be made neat, clean and intact as per the instruction of Bank and the Bank will not pay any amount for this.

(c) The Tender shall remain open for acceptance by the Bank for a period of ninety days from the date of opening of the Tender which period may be extended by the mutual agreement and the Tenderer shall not cancel or withdraw their offer during this period.

(vi) The contractors whose Tender is accepted shall take up the work in hand immediately and **complete it within 45 days from the date of the work order.**

(vii) The contractor shall visit the site before Quoting to acquaint themselves thoroughly with all the matters concerning the timely execution of the work. They should also be well conversant with the rates of Local Taxes and other rates and charges of the Government royalty charges etc. which are to be borne by them.

(viii) Materials to be used shall be strictly according to the specifications for work conforming to relevant Bureau of Indian Standards and of makes/Brands as approved. Samples of all the material/s to be used shall be got approved from the Bank before use.

(ix) The Bank reserves the right to reject/accept any or all the tenders or any part or parts of tenders without assigning any reasons thereof. The quantities mentioned in the Tender are approximate. Bank further reserves right to delete or reduce or distribute any item amongst vendors and payment of will be made on the basis of actual work done at the site.

(x) No request for advance will be entertained by the Bank. The Bank may consider the request for running payment for the work not less than Rs.10.00 lakh but no advance against the materials will be payable while making running account payments.

(xi) All works should be started simultaneously and as directed by the Bank's Engineer at site.

(xii) The Earnest Money will have to be deposited along with the tender.

(xiii) The contractor should take actual measurements of the work and submit them along with the running bill or the final bill. The Bank will verify the measurements before making payment of the bill.

(xiv) If the contractor fails to complete the work by time period as specified in the clause (vi) above or within any reasonable extended time given by the Bank, the contractor shall pay or allow the Bank the sum at a rate of Rs.0.5% of the tender amount per day and to a maximum of 5% as Liquidated Damages for the period during which the said works shall so remain incomplete and the Bank may deduct such damages from any moneys due to the contractors.

(xv) The Bank will recover from the contractor's charges for the electricity and water, if arranged by the Bank on actual basis. The contractors will make their own arrangement for stay of their workers and they will not be permitted to stay in the Bank premises.

(xvi) 10% of the amount of the running bill will be deducted in the Running Bill, it will be release at the time of settlement of final bill. 5% of the amount of the final bill including earnest money if any will be deducted and kept as retention amount. It will be released after defect liability period if the work is finally completed and approved by the Bank.

(xvii) If the work is not done as per the specifications, the Bank will have the right to get the defects rectified by you or deduct the amount considered reasonable by the Bank's Engineer.

(xviii) Final measurements of the work should be taken by the contractor only after completion of the work to the satisfaction of the Bank's Engineer. The Final bill should be submitted within a month on satisfactory completion of the work as stated above. No advance payment will be made by Bank.

(xix) Conditional quotations are liable for rejection.

(xx) 100 % retention money will be released after of maintenance period (defect liability period), if, no defect are found in the respective items.

(xxi) If the contractor fails to submit rates for three consecutive tender his/their name will be deleted from the list.

(xxii) In case you are not interested to quote your rates for subject work please return all the tender documents.

(xxiii) Please return this NIT in original in the sealed envelope along with the declaration mentioned below as a token of acceptance of all the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender.

(xxiv) The contractors are requested to acquaint themselves with the site conditions, terms & conditions, schedule of items and technical specifications of the tender and should seek requisite clarifications, if required, from the Bank Engineer at this office before quoting the rates.

(xxv) The contractor has to obtain approval of materials/samples from the Bank Engineer prior to its procurement and use in the work.

(xxvi) In case contractor fails to undertake the work at site within 7 days from the date of issue of work order, the Bank reserve the rights to entrust the work to any other contractor at its discretion and earnest money deposit of defaulter contractor will be forfeited.

(xxvii) The contractor should quote reasonable and workable rates for individual items. Wherever necessary, contractor, on demand, has to submit rate analysis of desired items within stipulated period.

(xxviii) The contractor shall not assign the contract. He shall not sublet any portion of the contract except with the prior written consent of the Bank.

(xxix) The quantities mentioned in the schedule of items are approximate and no further claims will be entertained for any change in the quantities.

(xxx) The successful tenderer is bound to carry out any items of work necessary for the completion of the job even though such items are not included in the quantities and rates. The rates for such items shall be decided by the bank within its sole discretion on the basis of rate analysis prepared by the contractor by taking into account prevailing market rates of material and labour involved and 15% contractor's profit.

(xxxi) The contractor shall study the schedule of items, technical specifications, drawings, design, etc. for its sufficiency considering all the regulations of local authorities and supply company and code of standard as applicable at the time of submitting the tender and shall bring to the notice addition or deletion, if any, in writing along with the tender.

(xxxii) If in the opinion of the Bank the rates quoted by any contractor are found unworkable keeping in view the specifications proposed and workmanship expected, the Bank may choose to reject such tenders within its sole discretion and without any notice to the contractors. Moreover, no claim/correspondence will be entertained by the Bank in such cases.

(xxxiii) The Bank may choose to split up the entire scope of work amongst any number of parties within its sole discretion irrespective of the lowest rates.

(xxxiv) The defect liability period for proposed work shall be twelve months from the date of Virtual Completion of the project. Any defects noticed during defects liability period will be rectified by the contractor at their cost within 7 days from the date of receipt of intimation (written/verbal/telephonic) from the bank failing which the Bank shall be at liberty to get the work done from any agency within its sole discretion at your risk, cost and consequences and cost thereof will be recovered from the contractor from any dues including retention money.

(xxxv) The contractor should maintain at site all mandatory registers including Hindrance register, site instruction book, labour register, cement consumption and receipt register etc. as directed at site.

(xxxvi) Before commencing execution of work at site, the contractors shall arrange for marking of layout at site and get the same approved from the Bank's Engineer/Architect.

(xxxvii) The contractors are advised to calculate the quantities of various items of work at their end as per actual site conditions and inform the bank in writing, if the variation in quantity/quantities of any one or more tender items vis-à-vis is actual required quantity is beyond 10%. However, no extra/additional work/quantity beyond tender quantity should be executed unless prior approval is accorded by the Bank. Please note that the Bank is not bound to make payment for any unauthorized extra/additional work exceeding the tender quantity executed by the contractor without proper authority from the Bank.

(xxxviii) The contractor should submit these terms & conditions duly signed as a token of acceptance, along with their tender, failure to which their tender is liable for rejection without any notice which please note.

(xxxix) All safety rules as per the CPWD specification, Indian Standards (IS), IE Rules 1956 and IE Act 2003 to be complied by the contractor for the captioned job. All the Electrical work must be carried out by a competent Electrical Contractor having valid 'A' class Electrical contractor licence issued by State Government. The contractor will be held responsible for all Electrical related issues and in case of any eventuality at site.

(xxxx) The contractor is totally responsible/liable for the work. The workers must wear the safety equipments like safety helmet, safety belt, etc. The contractor/ supervisor should be present at site during execution of work.
