

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A. INTRODUCTION

3.1 Broad Scope of Work:

3.1.1 Supply, installation, testing, commissioning and maintenance of Audio and Video Conference Systems at 9th Floor Boardroom of the Administrative Office Ernakulam of State Bank of India at Shanmugam Road. The contractor should provide a total of 4 years comprehensive warranty support after 1 year of the Defects Liability Period (DLP). The deliverables, consist of the Audio and Video conference systems and all associated accessories as specified in the Annexure I & 1(A) of this RFP, or as decided by the Bank, upon finalization, as deemed suitable. The Contractors should conduct a site survey of the Boardroom on any working days from 10:00AM to 5:00PM. (Please contact Mr. Priyesh Varghese Dy. Manager (C&C), State bank Of India, 9495701200 / 9447515516 to book an appointment prior to visit.).

3.2 Eligibility Criteria

3.3.1 This tender is open to contractors who meet the following conditions:

a) Work Experience: Should have work experience in the Audio Video systems integration field for more than 3 years and should have carried out similar works in Govt / Semi Govt / PSU / reputed large companies in Kerala in the past 3 years. The following combinations shall be considered for eligibility: Experience of having successfully completed similar work during last 3 years ending last day of 31.03.2024 as under:

(i) Three similar works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the annual estimated cost i.e. Rs.10 Lakhs each. OR

(ii) Two similar works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the annual estimated cost i.e. Rs.12.5 Lakhs each. OR

(iii) One similar work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the annual estimated cost i.e. Rs. 20 Lakhs.

b) Contractor should have a properly functioning office in Kerala. Satisfactory proof of such functioning office to be submitted along with technical bid. Availability of Service Centers: Contractor/OEM must have a Functional Service Centre in Kerala (Refer Annexure V). This is to ensure quick and assured after-sales service.

c) Scope: The Contractor should be able to supply, install, test, and commission all items in the Bill of Quantity (BOQ) list. A contractor's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't quote all products mentioned in Bill of Quantity in ANNEXURE- I (A)

d) The Contractor shall have CTS (Certified Technology Specialist) certified engineers for AV system installation in Kerala. Certificate copy to be attached along with ID card copies.

e) The contractor shall provide Manufacturers Authorization (ANNEXURE – II) with OEM details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid. This has to be submitted in the OEMs letterhead with technical bid for active devices like Audio DSP, Video Switchers, Video distribution amplifier, Audio amplifiers, Microphone, Control System, & Video Extenders.

f) Contractor should submit a gist of Specification/ Catalogues of quoted products along with technical bid. Data sheets and specifications need not be submitted as hard copy and can be sent as a password protected soft copy via email. Passwords can be shared in technical bid.

g) Unpriced Bill of Material with line-item wise Make and Model to be submitted along with Technical compliance.

h) **PO Copies of similar work done in the past 3 Years as per section 3.3.1 (a)**. The PO submitted should clearly show the split up of value of the work carried out, namely the type of



audio video equipment, and its unit values and works component. The value of AV equipment and integration alone will be counted towards minimum eligibility. If the PO is lumpsum and includes non AV components in such a way that Bank is are unable to ascertain the proportionate value of A/V in the PO, then the PO will not be considered.

i) The party shall provide any additional quantity of items listed in Bill of Quantity (BOQ) at the same rate as agreed in the purchase order during DLP.

3.3 Cost of Bidding: The Contractor shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid, and the Bank will not be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding process.

B. THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

3.4 Documents constituting the Bid

3.4.1 The Contractor shall examine all instructions, forms, terms, specifications, annexures and shedules in this Request For Proposal (here after the Bidding Document'). Failure to furnish all information required by the Bidding Document or to submit a Bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Document in every respect will be at the Contractor's risk and may result in the rejection of the Bid.

3.5 Clarification / Amendment of Bidding Document

3.5.1 Contractor requiring any clarification of the Bidding Document may notify the Bank in writing at the address or by e-mail indicated in Schedule of Dates on or before (time) on (date) indicated therein.

3.5.2 Text of queries raised (without identifying source of query) and response of the Bank together with amendment to the bidding document, if any will be posted on Bank's website. No individual clarification will be sent to the contractors. It is the responsibility of the contractor to check the website of The Bank before final submission of bids.

3.5.3 Relaxation in any of the terms contained in the Bid, in general, will not be permitted, but if granted, the same will be put up on Bank's Website.

3.5.4 All contractors must ensure that such clarifications / amendments have been considered by them before submitting the bid. The Bank will not take responsibility for any omissions by contractor.

3.5.5 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Bids, the Bank, for any reason, whether, at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Contractor, may modify the Bidding Document, by amendment.

3.5.6 In order to enable contractors reasonable time in which to take amendments into account in preparing the bids, the Bank, at its discretion, may extend the deadline for submission of bids.

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C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

3.6 Language of Bid

3.6.1 The Bid prepared by the Contractor, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Contractor and the Bank and supporting documents and printed literature shall be submitted in English.

3.7 Bid Prices through Price bid

3.7.1 Prices are to be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

3.7.2 Prices quoted should be exclusive of all Central / State Government levies, GST, any other taxes. Prices quoted should be inclusive of Comprehensive warranty for 4 years after completion of Defects Liability Period (DLP) of One year. Prices quoted should also include cost of incidental services such as end to end transportation, insurance, excise duty, custom duty, cost of imports etc.

3.7.3 Prices quoted by the Contractor shall be fixed during the Contractor's performance of the Contract and shall not be subject to variation on any account, including exchange rate fluctuations, changes in taxes, duties, levies, charges etc. A Bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and will be rejected.

3.8 Delivery Schedule & Penalty for Delayed Deliveries

3.8.1 Delivery of all equipment should be within 30 days from the date of placement of purchase order. Installation should be done within 5 days from the date of delivery. Testing and training should be completed within 10 days from the date of delivery.

3.8.2 If the equipment is not delivered, installed, tested and commissioned within **40 days** from date of purchase order, a penalty of one (1) percent of the total consideration will be imposed for each week or part thereof the delay, Nevertheless, this penalty will not surpass ten (10) percent of the total consideration.

3.8.3 The penalty shall be deducted at the time of making final payment after successful installation and commissioning of hardware.

3.8.4 The Bank also reserves the right to cancel the Purchase Order and forfeit the EMD. In case of breach of clause 3.8.1 above by the successful contractor. In the event of such cancellation, the contractor is not entitled to any compensation.

THE DELIVERY SCHEDULE SHALL BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED AS STIPULATED. AND PENALTIES SHALL BE FOR LEVIED DELAYED DELIVERY

3.9 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): The EMD amount shall be Rupees Twenty-Five Thousand only (Rs.25,000/-) in the form of Demand Draft in favour of the bank. The EMD of the unsuccessful contractor shall be refunded without interest soon after the decision to award the contract is taken. The EMD shall stand absolutely forfeited if the contractor revokes his tender at any time during the period when he is required to keep his tender open acceptance by the SBI or after it is accepted by the SBI the contractor falls to enter into a formal Agreement or fails to pay the initial security deposit as stipulated or fails to commence the work within the stipulated time.

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3.10 Period of Validity of Bids

3.10.1 Bids shall remain valid for a period of 180 days i.e. from the date of price bid.

3.10.2 In exceptional circumstances, the Bank may solicit the Contractors' consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. 3.10.3 The Bank reserves the right to call for fresh quotes any time during the validity period, if considered necessary.

3.11 Format and Signing of Bid

3.11.1 Each bid shall be in the following parts:-

Part I- Technical Proposal. (Online)

Technical proposal will be online and the EMD should be submitted in sealed NON-WINDOW envelopes, each superscribed with "REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR PROCUREMENT, INSTALLATION, COMMISSIONING, TESTING AND MAINTENANCE WORKS OF AUDIO VIDEO (AV) SYSTEM FOR 9TH FLOOR BOARDROOM AT AO ERNAKULAM "

Part II- Financial Bid. (Through online Price Bid)

3.11.1 Financial bid submission will be online.

3.11.2 Any supporting documents uploaded to the e-tendering portal should be clear and legible. Documents uploaded shall be signed by the Contractor or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the Contractor to the Contract. The person or persons signing the Bids shall initial all such pages.

3.11.3 Any inter-lineation, erasures or overwriting shall be valid **only** if they are initialed by the person signing the Bids. The Bank reserves the right to reject bids not conforming to the above.

D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

3.12 Sealing and Marking of Bids

3.12.1 The Contractors' shall seal the NON-WINDOW envelope containing the EMD. Technical bid has to be done online in <u>https://etender.sbi</u>. All prospective contractors should register in the portal well before the last date of submission.

3.12.2 The envelope shall:

a) be addressed to the Bank at the address given in Part-I ; and

b) bear superscription the Project Name **"REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR PROCUREMENT, INSTALLATION, COMMISSIONING, TESTING AND MAINTENANCE WORKS OF AUDIO VIDEO (AV) SYSTEM AT AO ERNAKULAM.**

3.12.3 All envelopes should indicate the name and address of the Contractor on the cover.



3.12.3 If the envelope is not sealed and marked, the Bank will assume no responsibility for the EMD's misplacement or its premature opening.

3.13 Deadline for Submission of Bids

3.13.1 Bids must submitted online, no later than the date & time specified in the "Schedule of Events" in Invitation to Bid.

3.13.2 In the event of the specified date for submission of bids being declared a holiday for the Bank, the bids will be received up to the appointed time on the next working day.

3.13.3 The Bank may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids by amending the bid documents, in which case, all rights and obligations of the Bank and contractors previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the extended deadline.

3.14 Late Bids: Any Bid received after the deadline for submission of Bids prescribed, will be rejected.

3.15 Evaluation of Price Bids and Finalization

3.15.1 Only those Contractors who qualify in Technical evaluation would be shortlisted for commercial evaluation via Price bid conducted by the Bank's authorized eProcurement service provider, details of which will provided to technically qualified contractors only.

3.15.2 The L1 Contractor will be chosen based on the net total of the price evaluation as provided in the Price bid. The net total quoted by each contractor should encompass all costs associated with this project, including the supply of hardware, installation, testing, works, project management, and a 4-year comprehensive extended warranty (following the DLP of one year). The cost of the 4-year comprehensive extended warranty (after the DLP of one year) must be factored into the price evaluation. However, payment for such warranty charges will be made quarterly in arrears after the commencement of the warranty period. No warranty charges will be paid during the defect liability period.

3.15.3 Arithmetic errors, if any, in the price breakup format will be rectified as under :

(a) If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and total price which is obtained by multiplying the unit price with quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected unless it is a lower figure. If the contractor does not accept the correction of errors, the bid will be rejected.

(b) If there is a discrepancy in the unit price quoted in figures and words, the unit price in figures or in words, as the case may be, which corresponds to the total bid price for the bid shall be taken as correct.

(c) If the contractor has not worked out the total bid price or the total bid price does not correspond to the unit price quoted either in words or figures, the unit price quoted in words shall be taken as correct.



(d) Bank may waive off any minor infirmity or non-conformity or irregularity in a bid, which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such a waiving does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any contractor.

3.16 Contacting the Bank

3.16.1 No Contractor shall contact the Bank on any matter relating to its Bid, from the time of submission of Price Bid to the time the Contract is awarded.

3.16.2 Any effort by a Contractor to influence the Bank in its decisions on Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or contract award may result in the rejection of the Contractor's Bid.

3.17 Award Criteria

3.17.1 The Bank will award the Contract to the successful Contractor who has been determined to qualify to perform the Contract satisfactorily, and whose Bid has been determined to be responsive, and is the lowest evaluated Bid.

3.17.2 The Bank reserves the right at the time of award of contract to increase or decrease the quantity of goods and / or services or change in location where equipment are to be supplied from what was originally specified while floating the RFP without any change in unit price or any other terms and conditions.

3.18 Bank's right To Accept Any Bid and to reject any or All Bids: The Bank reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid in part or in full or to cancel the Bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award, without incurring any liability to the affected Contractor or Contractors or any obligation to inform the affected Contractor or Contractors of the grounds for the Bank's action.

3.19 Notification of Award

3.19.1 Prior to expiration of the period of Bid validity, the Bank will notify the successful Contractor in writing or by e-mail, that his Bid has been accepted.

3.19.2 The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract. The selected Contractor should convey acceptance of the award of contract by returning duly signed and stamped duplicate copy of the award letter within 7 days of receipt of the communication.

3.19.3 Upon notification of award to the L1 Contractor , the Bank will promptly notify each unsuccessful Contractor and will discharge its EMD.

3.20 Performance Bank Guarantee: As mentioned in payment terms

3.21 Signing of Contract:

3.21.1 After awarding the award/bid the bank and the successful contractor will enter into a contract on the terms and conditions contained in the bid document and other terms mutually agreed between the parties.



3.21.2 In the absence of a formal contract, the Bid document, together with the Bank's notification of award and the contractor's acceptance thereof, would constitute a binding contract between the Bank and the successful Contractor.

3.21.3 Failure of the successful Contractor to comply with the requirements listed in Annexure I & 1(A) shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award.

3.21.4 The Bank reserves the right either to invoke the Performance Bank Guarantee or to cancel the purchase order or both if the Contractor fails to meet the terms of this RFP or contracts entered into with them

PART - 4. TENTATIVE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (TCC)

The following terms and conditions shall be tentative and shall be finalized at the time of finalizing the Contract.

4.1 Definitions : In this Contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

4.1.1 "The Bank" means State Bank of India a body corporate constituted under the provisions of State Bank Of India act,1955 and having its corporate BRANCH at State Bank Bhavan, Madame Cama Road, Nariman Point Mumbai -400021 and having one of its Administrative office at Ernakulam and acting through ITS Department.

4.1.2 "The Contract" means the Agreement entered into between the Bank and the successful contractor, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein;

4.1.3 "Contractor" is the successful Contractor whose technical bid has been accepted and whose price as per the commercial bid is the lowest and to whom notification of award has been given by Bank.

4.1.4 "The Contract Price" means the price payable to the Contractor under the Contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligations;

4.1.5 "The Equipment" means all the hardware / software and / or services which the Contractor is required to supply to the Bank under the Contract;

4.1.6 "The Services" means those services ancillary to the supply of the Products, such as transportation and insurance, installation, commissioning, customization, provision of technical assistance, training, maintenance and other such obligations of the Contractor covered under the Contract;

4.1.7 "TCC" means the Terms and Conditions of Contract contained in this section;

4.1.8 "The Project" means supply, installation, testing and commissioning of the audio video system and all accessories Mentioned in Annexure (1 & 1A) with 4 years comprehensive warranty support after 1 year of Defects Liability Period (DLP)



4.1.9 "The Project Site" means the boardroom at 9th floor of Administrative Office (AO) Ernakulam of the State Bank of India where the equipment is to be supplied, installed and commissioned.

4.1.10 "The defects liability period (or 'DLP')" is a fixed period of time, starting from the date of practical completion, during which the contractor has an express contractual right to return to the site to rectify any defects which have appeared in that contractor's work since the date of completion. The contractor shall provide any additional quantity of items listed in Bill of Quantity (BOQ) at the same rate as agreed in the purchase order during DLP.

4.1.11 Uptime: Uptime refers to the duration during which a system, service, or network is operational and available for use by its intended users. It is the period when the system is functioning correctly and fulfilling its purpose without interruption or failure.

4.1.12 Downtime: Downtime, on the other hand, refers to the period when a system, service, or network is not operational or unavailable for use. It occurs when the system experiences an interruption, failure, or scheduled maintenance, preventing users from accessing or utilizing the service.

In case of a difference of opinion on the part of the Contractor in comprehending and/or interpreting any clause / provision of the Bid Document after submission of the Bid, the interpretation by the Bank shall be binding and final on the Contractor.

4.2 Use of Contract Documents and Information

4.2.1 The successful contractor shall not, without the Bank's prior written consent, disclose the Contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample or information furnished by or on behalf of the Bank in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the successful contractor in the performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only so far as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.

4.2.2 The successful contractor will treat as confidential all data and information about the Bank, obtained in the execution of his responsibilities, in strict confidence and will not reveal such information to any other party without the prior written approval of the Bank.

4.3. Country of Origin / Eligibility of Goods & Services Restriction on Procurement due to National Security: Government of India order F. No. 7/86/2020/BOA-I dated 07.08.2020 on restrictions on procurements from contractors from a country or countries, on grounds of defense in India, or matters directly or indirectly, related thereto, including national security is applicable for this RFP.

4.3.1 Any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the contractor is registered with the Competent Authority. (The Bank's Registration Committee constituted by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT)).

4.3.2 "Contractor" (including the term 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) means any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical



person not falling in any of the descriptions of contractors stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.

4.3.3 "Contractor from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means: -

a. An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or

b. A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such country; or

c. An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or

d. An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or

e. An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or

f. A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or

g. A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.

4.3.4 The beneficial owner for the purpose of 4.3.3(d) above will be as under: In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through other means.

Explanation

a. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five per cent. of shares or capital or profits of the company.

b. "Control" shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders Agreements or voting Agreements.

4.3.5 In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s). who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership.

4.3.6 In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of individuals; Where no natural person is identified under 4.3.5 above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official;

4.3.7 In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

4.3.8 An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.

4.3.9 The successful contractor shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority.



4.3.10 All goods and related services to be supplied under the Contract shall have their origin in eligible source countries, as per the prevailing Import Trade Control Regulations in India 4.3.11 For purposes of this clause, "origin" means the place where the goods are mined, grown, or manufactured or produced, or the place from which the related services are supplied. Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially-recognized product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.

4.4. Use of Contract Documents and Information

4.4.1 The Contractor shall not, without the Bank's prior written consent, disclose the Contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample or information furnished by or on behalf of the Bank in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the Contractor in the performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only as far as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.

4.4.2 The Contractor shall not, without the Bank's prior written consent, make use of any document or information disclosed by Bank except for purposes of performing the Contract.

4.4.3 Any document, other than the Contract itself, shall remain the property of the Bank and shall be returned (in all copies) to the Bank on completion of the Contractor's performance under the Contract, if so required by the Bank.

4.5. Patent Rights

4.5.1 In the event of any claim asserted by a third party of infringement of copyright, patent, trademark, industrial design rights, etc. arising from the use of the Goods or any part thereof in India, the successful contractor shall act expeditiously to extinguish such claim. If the Contractor fails to comply and the Bank is required to pay compensation to a third party resulting from such infringement, the Contractor shall be responsible for the compensation to claimant including all expenses, court costs and lawyer fees. The Bank will give notice to the Contractor of such claim, if it is made, without delay. The Contractor shall indemnify the Bank against all third-party claims. The obligation of the Contractor under this clause shall be unlimited.

4.6 Payment Terms

Payment shall be made in Indian Rupees.

4.6.1 70% of the material invoice value shall be released after delivery of all materials at Location and on submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to the 10% of the cost of the entire project cost (including Warranty) valid till 3 months after expiry of the warranty period. PBG in this tender should be valid for five years and three months.

4.6.2 Remaining 30% of the material invoice value and 100 % of works component shall be released against successful testing and commissioning of the work in its entirety subject to submission and verification of PBG in 4.6.1.

4.6.3 If PBG is not submitted and the work is completed and handed over to the bank, 90% payment (inclusive of security deposit components as applicable) will be released and balance 10% shall be released after warranty period after deducting security deposit components.

4.6.4 Warranty costs will not be payable during the Defects Liability Period of 1 year from handover. The warranty costs will be paid for the subsequent 4 years quarterly in arrears subject



to satisfactory performance from the second year onwards. The warranty start date will be calculated as one year after the date of acceptance of the work by the Bank or its representatives. 4.6.5 Successful commissioning and acceptance certificate as mentioned in Annexure III is mandatory for processing the payment.

4.6.6 Payments will not be released for any part-shipment or short-shipments.

4.7 Prices

4.7.1 Prices payable to the Contractor as stated in the Contract shall be firm and not subject to

adjustment during performance of the Contract, irrespective of reasons whatsoever, including exchange rate fluctuations, changes in taxes, duties, levies, charges, etc.

4.7.2 The Contractor will pass on to the Bank, all fiscal benefits arising out of reductions, if any, in Government levies viz. sales tax, excise duty, custom duty, etc. or the benefit of discounts if any announced in respect of the cost of the items for which orders have been placed during that period.

4.7.3 The Bank reserves the right to re-negotiate the prices in the event of a change in the international market prices of both the hardware and software.

5. **Governing Language:** The governing language shall be English.

6. Applicable Law: The Contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Union of India and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Ernakulam.

7.2 A notice shall be effective when delivered or on effective date of the notice whichever is later. The address should be submitted along with the EMD.



8. Taxes and Duties

The Contractor will be entirely responsible for all applicable taxes like Central / State Government levies, GST, sales tax, VAT, excise duty, cess, charges, license fees, road permits, service tax etc. in connection with delivery of products at site including incidental services and commissioning. Payment of Octroi and /or Entry Tax, alone, if applicable, will be reimbursed at actuals upon production of original receipts.

Income / Corporate Taxes in India: The Contractor shall be liable to pay all corporate taxes and income tax that shall be levied according to the laws and regulations applicable from time to time in India and the price bid by the Contractor shall include all such taxes in the contract price.

Tax deduction at Source: Wherever the laws and regulations require deduction of such taxes at the source of payment, the Bank shall effect such deductions from the payment due to the Contractor. The remittance of amounts so deducted and issuance of certificate for such deductions shall be made by the Bank as per the laws and regulations in force. Nothing in the Contract shall relieve the Contractor from his responsibility to pay any tax that may be levied in India on income and profits made by the Contractor in respect of this contract.

The Contractor's staff, personnel and labour will be liable to pay personal income taxes in India in respect of such of their salaries and wages as are chargeable under the laws and regulations for the time being in force, and the Contractor shall perform such duties in regard to such deductions thereof as may be imposed on him by such laws and regulations.

The proposed board room is 25-seater and the participants use the room in 4 modes as listed below:

1. Conducting H.323/Sip Video conferences (VC) using hardware codec.

2. Conducting Cloud VC like MS Teams, Webex or Zoom using soft codecs on LAPTOP /PC connected to USB Camera and Audio input and output will be connected to proposed audio system via 3.5 audio cable and USB. Laptop and Camera is already available and has to integrated to this new equipment. All remaining items and accessories will come under the project scope.

3. Hybrid mode (using mode 1 and mode 2 mentioned above concurrently): We use cloud VC and H.323 Codec at the same time to connect between multiple platforms. The audio system supplied should interconnect or bridge the audio streams of cloud VC and hardware VC with the room audio. This programing should be done without causing echo and disturbances to near-end and far-end users of both systems. The system should enable smooth audio as well as video communication among all parties. Contractors having adequate documented experience in rolling out hybrid mode projects including DSP programing, mixing, bridging and federation should only apply for the bid. Proof of the same should be submitted during the technical evaluation round. PO copy or RFP where such a functionality is clearly mentioned will be accepted as proof. 

WHEREAS THE CONTRACTOR has agreed to provide and THE BANK has agreed to accept from THE CONTRACTOR, repair and comprehensive maintenance service for audio and video hardware and peripherals installed at 9th floor Boardroom, AO Ernakulam of THE BANK (hereinafter called **"THE SITE")** and listed in **'ANNEXURE 1 & 1(A)'** hereto as amended from time to time (hereinafter called "THE EQUIPMENTS") subject to The BANK paying charges to THE CONTRACTOR and on the following terms and conditions:

1. CONTRACT PERIOD:

1. 1. This Agreement is effective from ------ and it shall be valid for a period of five years viz. up to------. This includes 4 year of warranty after defect liability period of one year. 3.4 By offering to provide Comprehensive Maintenance Service for THE EQUIPMENTS, THE CONTRACTOR is giving an implicit confirmation to THE BANK that the satisfactory discharge of comprehensive maintenance service is not going to suffer due to lack of spares. The offer of comprehensive maintenance service by THE CONTRACTOR implies an unequivocal undertaking that THE CONTRACTOR is holding sufficient spares in respect of THE EQUIPMENTS, as THE CONTRACTOR itself has manufactured / supplied THE EQUIPMENTS to THE BANK or that THE CONTRACTOR is in a position to procure sufficient spares for THE EQUIPMENTS either through back-to-back arrangements with the manufacturer or through procurement from the open market - and therefore, the satisfactory discharge of the warranty shall not suffer due to lack of spares.

4. PENALTY CLAUSE:

4.2 The uptime shall be computed on quarterly basis.



4.3 In the event of two consecutive breakdowns of any equipment within a span of two weeks, THE BANK reserves the right to treat the intervening period as downtime and recover the penalty out of the payments due to THE CONTRACTOR or through any other legal measures as deemed fit.

4.4 For the purpose of calculation of the uptime working day (Total time) is defined as a twelvehour period from 08.00 Hrs. to 20.00 Hrs.

4.5 System Uptime for the purpose of the penalty clause is defined as productive and error free time of THE EQUIPMENT reckoned on a quarterly basis and the system uptime efficiency shall be computed as under:

[(Total Time minus Down Time) Divided by Total Time] multiplied by 100

4.6 THE CONTRACTOR shall provide repair and maintenance service, in response to complaint / request for repair of equipment by oral, including telephone or email/letter by THE BANK so that lead time for carrying out repairs of THE EQUIPMENT and making it operational does not exceed 24 hours, failing which a penalty of Rs.500/- for each occasion will be deducted from the quarterly Warranty charges payable to THE CONTRACTOR.

4.7 In case whenever the defects / faults are not set right / rectified before the end of the third business day after lodgment of complaint (without reckoning the date of complaint), THE BANK will impose, at its absolute discretion, on THE CONTRACTOR a penalty of Rs.500/- per day.

4.8 The maximum penalty chargeable per quarter is limited to 5% of the quarterly warranty charges payable to THE CONTRACTOR.

4.9 In case the defects / faults are not set right / rectified before the end of the third business day after lodgment of complaint and THE BANK is constrained to set right/repair THE EQUIPMENT through outside agencies, costs/charges thereof shall be recovered from THE CONTRACTOR, in addition to the penalty chargeable.

5. FORCE MAJEURE:

Notwithstanding the provisions mentioned in the Agreement, THE CONTRACTOR shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages, or termination for default if and to the extent that the delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.



For purposes of this clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of THE CONTRACTOR and not involving THE CONTRACTOR's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may in the nature of wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, and freight embargoes.

If a Force Majeure situation arises, THE CONTRACTOR shall promptly notify THE BANK in writing of such condition and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by THE BANK in writing, THE CONTRACTOR shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.

6. SUBCONTRACTING

6.1 THE CONTRACTOR shall not subcontract or permit anyone other than the personnel engaged by them to perform any of the work, services or other performance required to be performed by THE CONTRACTOR under this agreement without the prior written permission of THE BANK.

7. CHANGES IN ANNEXURE

7.1 THE BANK shall have the right to make changes and attachments to THE EQUIPMENTS, provided that such changes and/or attachments do not prevent proper maintenance from being performed by THE CONTRACTOR as required under this Agreement or unreasonably increases the cost of THE CONTRACTOR for performing repair and maintenance service.

8. LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

8.1. THE CONTRACTOR shall comply with all applicable laws in performing the obligations under this Agreement including but not limited to the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, as may be applicable.

9. SECURITY

9.1 THE CONTRACTOR agrees that THE CONTRACTOR and its personnel will at all times comply with all security regulations in effect from time to time at THE BANK's premises and externally for materials belonging to THE BANK.

10. CONFIDENTIALITY:

10.1 THE CONTRACTOR acknowledges that all materials and information which has or will come into its possession or knowledge in connection with this Agreement or the performance hereof, consists of confidential and proprietary data whose disclosure to or use by third parties will be damaging or cause loss to THE BANK. THE CONTRACTOR agrees to hold such material and information in strictest confidence and not to make use thereof other than for the performance of



the obligations under this Agreement, to release it only to employees requiring such information and not to release or disclose it to any other person. THE CONTRACTOR agrees to take appropriate action with respect to its employees to ensure that the obligations of non-use and non-disclosure of confidential information under this Agreement are fully satisfied.

11. WARRANTY

11.1 THE CONTRACTOR represents and warrants that the repair and maintenance service / products hereby sold do not violate or infringe upon any patent, copy right, trade secret or other property right of any other person or other entity.

12. INDEMNITY:

12.1. THE CONTRACTOR agrees that it shall keep THE BANK always indemnified against all or any loss, damage, costs (including as between attorney and client) and all expenses which may arise on account of any claim from any third party arising out of any breach or claimed breach or the failure of THE CONTRACTOR or any of its employees or agents by whatsoever name he/she is called, of the above clauses on security, confidentiality and/ or warranty, whether the loss, damage, costs or expenses arise directly or indirectly from such breach or failure. THE CONTRACTOR also agrees to keep THE BANK indemnified of any loss caused to THE BANK due to loss/damage, if any, caused to THE EQUIPMENTS on account of any reason attributable to the employees/agents of THE CONTRACTOR.

13. BUSINESS TERMINATION:

13.1 In the event that THE CONTRACTOR shall cease conducting business in the normal course or wind up, make a general assignment for the benefit of creditors, suffer or permit the appointment of a receiver for its business or assets or shall avail itself of, or become subject to, any proceeding under any act or statute of any country or state resulting to insolvency or the protection of rights of creditors, then (notwithstanding the option of THE BANK in clause 1.1 of the agreement) at the discretion of THE BANK, this Agreement shall stand terminated and be of no further force and effect and any property or rights of such other party, tangible or intangible, shall forthwith be returned to it.

14. TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT

Termination for Insolvency : THE BANK may, at any time, terminate the Contract by giving written notice to THE CONTRACTOR if THE CONTRACTOR becomes Bankrupt or otherwise insolvent. In this event, termination will be without compensation to THE CONTRACTOR, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy, which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to THE BANK.



4.10 Termination for Convenience : THE BANK, by written notice sent to THE CONTRACTOR, may terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for THE BANK's convenience, the extent to which performance of THE CONTRACTOR under the Contract is terminated, and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.

15. DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM:

15.1 THE BANK and THE CONTRACTOR shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation, any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract.

If, THE BANK and THE CONTRACTOR have been unable to resolve amicably a Contract dispute even after a reasonably long period, either party may require that the dispute be referred for resolution to the formal mechanisms specified herein below. These mechanisms may include, but are not restricted to, conciliation mediated by a third party and/or adjudication in an agreed national forum.

The dispute resolution mechanism to be applied shall be as follows:

(a) In case of Dispute or difference arising between THE BANK and THE CONTRACTOR relating to any matter arising out of or connected with this Agreement, such disputes or difference shall be settled in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Where the value of the Contract is above Rs.1.00 Crore, the arbitral tribunal shall consist of 3 arbitrators, one each to be appointed by THE BANK and the successful contractor. The third Arbitrator shall be chosen by mutual discussion between THE BANK and the successful contractor. Where the value of the contract is Rs.1.00 Crore and below, the disputes or differences arising shall be referred to a Sole Arbitrator who shall be appointed by Agreement between the parties.

(b) Arbitration proceedings shall be held at ERNAKULAM, and the language of the arbitration proceedings and that of all documents and communications between the parties shall be English; (c) The decision of the majority of arbitrators shall be final and binding upon both parties. The cost and expenses of Arbitration proceedings will be paid as determined by the arbitral tribunal. However, the expenses incurred by each party in connection with the preparation, presentation, etc., of its proceedings as also the fees and expenses paid to the arbitrator appointed by such party or on its behalf shall be borne by each party itself. If, THE BANK and THE CONTRACTOR have been unable to resolve amicably a dispute even after a reasonable period then the matter may be referred to the court of law. The parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of ERNAKULAM for the determination of disputes arising under or in connection with this Agreement.



16. GENERAL:

16.1 No amendment to this Agreement shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of both the parties.

16.2 Each party warrants and guarantees that it has full power and authority to enter into and perform this Agreement, and the person signing this Agreement on behalf of each has been properly been authorized and empowered to enter into this Agreement. Each party further acknowledges and confirms that it has read this Agreement, understood it and agrees to be bound by it.
